Products Potentially Eligible for Duty-Free Treatment under AGOA if Imported from Eligible Sub-Saharan Africa Countries

The following is a list of products that are being considered for duty-free treatment, if imported from AGOA beneficiary countries, under AGOA. A determination of what products will be granted duty-free treatment is expected by the end of 2000 and will be published in the Federal Register and available at www.agoa.gov.

These products are arranged by broad product groupings and, within those groupings, classified numerically according to the Harmonized Tariff System (HTS) of the United States. The tariff schedule which details all of the HTS codes applicable to all products imported into the United States may be accessed through the Internet at <http://www.usitc.gov/taffairs.htm>

Note: If there is an A+ under GSP Status that means that the product is currently duty-free under GSP for countries designated as “least-developed beneficiary developing countries” under GSP. A list of these countries is included at Annex 1.
